We do not return to unplug them in the spring. Please make your own arrangements for this service. We recommend that you have your heat tapes plugged in by October 31st.


Current Events for October 2020:

HALLOWEEN TRICK OR TREATING TIPS

Residents: If you wish to pass out candy for Halloween on October 31st, please leave your porch light on. If you wish *not* to



pass out candy, or if you run out of candy, please leave your porch light off.

Parents: Please make sure your child is carrying a flashlight and/or wearing something reflective so they can be seen by motorists. All costumes and wigs should be labeled "flame retardant". Costumes should fit well so as not to cause a tripping hazard. FDA face paint is best, but if masks are worn, they should fit well so children can see. Please check all candy to ensure it is safe. Warn children to never enter homes without a trusted adult, and to never accept rides from strangers, or anyone else for that matter, unless the parent has approved of it first. Advise trick or treaters to always stay to the side of roads and to be aware of traffic as well as cars in driveways.

Reminder: Please don't overstuff your leaf bags.



Place your bagged leaves near the edge of your lawn for pick up. Please remember our maintenance crew need to lift these bags quite high to get them into the truck. If the bags weigh more than 50lbs, they will not be

picked up and you will need to re-bag them into lighter bags. Please do not rake leaves onto the vacant lots. This creates more work for the maintenance staff and they just blow around into everyone's yard. Bag your leaves and place them at the end of your driveway for free pickup. Thank you

PUMPKIN WHOOPIE PIES Ingredients


18 servings 425 cals

- 2 cups packed brown sugar
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 1 1/2 cups solid pack pumpkin puree
- 2 eggs
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 1/2 tablespoons ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tablespoon ground ginger
- 1/2 tablespoon ground cloves
- 1 egg white
- 2 tablespoons milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups confectioners' sugar
- 3/4 cup shortening
- Add all ingredients to list

Directions

- **1.** Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Lightly grease baking sheets.
- 2. Combine the oil and brown sugar. Mix in the pumpkin and eggs, beating well. Add the flour, salt, baking powder, baking soda, 1 teaspoon vanilla, cinnamon, ginger and cloves. Mix well.
- 3. Drop dough by heaping teaspoons onto the prepared baking sheets. Bake at 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) for 10 to 12 minutes. Let cookies cool then make sandwiches from two cookies filled with Whoopie Pie Filling.

To Make Whoopie Pie Filling: Beat egg white and mix with the milk, 1 teaspoon vanilla and 1 cup of the confectioners' sugar. Mix well then beat in the shortening and the remaining cup of confectioners' sugar. Beat until light and fluffy.

New Fee Schedule for Town Trash Bags and Town Trash Tags and Discontinuance of Town Trash Bags

Gorham, Maine (September 2, 2020) — The Town of Gorham will be transitioning entirely to Town trash tags starting **January 1, 2021** for curbside collection and will be

discontinuing Town trash bags. Town trash tags have been in circulation since May 2016 and are seen to be a more effective way to reduce trash volume. Existing Town trash bags will continue to be honored until their supply is exhausted. Town trash tags are available for sale at local stores as well as municipal facilities. Town trash tags are to be adhered to the resident's privately purchased trash bag to signify to the Town's curbside collection contractor that the resident has paid for collection.

There will be a new sale price for the Town of Gorham trash bags and Town trash tags on the coming October distribution. With the Town Council's approval on 9/1/2020, the new fee schedule will be as follows:

Small Trash Bags: \$2.15 each — sold at \$21.50 per pouch (10) Large Trash Bags: \$4.30 each — sold at \$21.50 per pouch (5) Small Bag Tag: \$1.50 each — sold at \$7.50 per sheet (5) Large Bag Tag: \$3.00 each — sold at \$15.00 per sheet (5)

VOTE VOTE VOTE!!!

If you would like to register to vote in Gorham, please come into the Town Clerk's office and fill out a voter registration card. It is important that you show I.D. that has your Gorham residence address on it. Voter registration can take place anytime during our office hours. You may also register to vote on Election Day itself but you must show an I.D. showing your Gorham residence address. Proper I.D. could be a Maine Drivers License, car registration, utility bill or even an envelope that has gone through the mail to you at your Gorham address. P.O. Box addresses cannot be accepted.

Mid October to day before Election Day:

Early Voting will be available at the Gorham Town Office starting early October, call the Town Clerk's office for info: 207-222 -1670 (I did not have a start date at publish time). Early voting you stop by the Town Office and vote anytime during their normal busines hours.

November 3rd: Friendly Village is Ward 2 and voting will be at the Gorham High School off Morrell Avenue. Polling places open at 7:00 am and close at 8:00 pm.
